Professional Experience:

Primary Curriculum Areas

Applicants must identify at least one year of full-time studies in an Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) Level 7 or higher university subjects relevant to **one or more of the Western Australian Primary curriculum areas**. In Australia, 1 year of full-time studies in any recognised bachelor's degree would be displayed as a minimum of eight 0.125 Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL) units.

Complete applications will list at least eight individual units in **one or more in the Western Australian Primary curriculum content areas**. Applications that do not list 1 year of full-time study in the space below will constitute as an incomplete application and will not be processed.

Applicants who identify significant gaps of knowledge within the prescribed subjects of their teaching area may close their application with the admissions team and contact the Master of Teaching academic chair for study advice. *This form must be presented to the academic chair to ensure a proper pathway to the Master of Teaching is established for the applicant.*
